(Los Angeles, CA) February 23, 2017 – From the first notes to the final breath, *West Side Story* is one of the most memorable musicals and greatest love stories of all time. As powerful, poignant, and timely as ever, the thrilling Leonard Bernstein and Stephen Sondheim score – including "Tonight," "Maria," "America" and the classic "Somewhere," remains one of the best-ever written. Shakespeare's *Romeo and Juliet* is transported to modern-day New York City, caught between warring street gangs, the Jets and the Sharks. Their struggle to survive in a world of hate, violence, and prejudice is one of the most innovative, heart-wrenching and relevant musical dramas of our time.

West Side Story will be presented for four performances March 10 to 12, 2017 at Valley Performing Arts Center (VPAC); followed by an engagement from April 21, 2017 through May 14, 2017 (press opening April 22) at La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts in La Mirada, California.

This La Mirada Theatre for the Performing Arts and McCoy Rigby production of *West Side Story* with book by Arthur Laurents and lyrics by Stephen Sondheim, music by Leonard Bernstein, is directed by Richard Israel, with musical direction by Brent Crayon, and choreography by John Todd.

As the world prepares for the Centennial of legendary American composer Leonard Bernstein to kick off in August, La Mirada Theatre and VPAC present perhaps his greatest musical; *West Side Story* is also only the second full-scale musical to be presented at VPAC, the award-winning performing arts center, following last season's La Mirada Theatre-McCoy Rigby production of *Dreamgirls*.

The cast of West Side Story features Eddie Egan as Tony (McCoy Rigby tour of Miss Saigon); Ashley Marie as Maria (West Side Story at Musical Theatre West and Riverside Repertory Theatre); Marlene Martinez

as Anita (National Tour of *Mamma Mia!*); Michael Starr as Riff (McCoy Rigby *Carrie: The Musical*); and Armando Yearwood, Jr. as Bernardo (International Tour of *West Side Story*).

"We have some terrific news about our plans for the Bernstein@100 celebration that we'll announce during the run of West Side Story," said Thor Steingraber, Executive Director of VPAC. "We are also excited to continue our collaboration with McCoy Rigby Entertainment and La Mirada Theatre to bring full-scale musicals to our audience." Tom McCoy said, "West Side Story is as timely now as ever before and I know our audiences will be captivated by this ground breaking show – and we are happy to have performances at VPAC prior to bringing it to our La Mirada home."
