Diana Krall Returns to The Soraya

One Night Only on May 14, 2025

LOS ANGELES (December 3, 2024) - GRAMMY[®] Award winning and multi-platinum jazz singer Diana Krall has announced she will embark on a nationwide 35-city U.S. tour, commencing on April 22, 2025 in Dallas, TX at the AT&T Performing Arts Center. Spanning over four months, the tour will make stops in Las Vegas, San Diego, Portland, Pittsburgh, Nashville, and more before concluding in Atlanta, GA on July 11. Krall will return to The Soraya for the first time in 10 years for one night only at 8 p.m. on Wednesday, May 14.

Tickets to Krall's concert at The Soraya go on sale to Soraya Members at 10 a.m. on Friday, Dec. 6, with access to the exclusive Members Only Seating Section. Public access will open at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 10.

A record-breaking musician, Diana Krall is the only jazz singer to have eight albums debut at the top of the Billboard Jazz Albums chart. Her albums have garnered two GRAMMY[®] Awards, ten Juno[®] Awards and have earned nine Gold, three Platinum, and seven multi-Platinum status albums. Her 1999 release of *When I Look in Your Eyes* spent an unprecedented 52 weeks in the #1 position on Billboard's Jazz chart, won two GRAMMY[®] Awards, and went Platinum in the U.S. and Canada, establishing her as a powerhouse of the genre. Her album, *This Dream of You*, garnered critical acclaim and displayed the effortless virtuosity that has time and time again earned Diana Krall status as an icon. Krall's unique artistry and musicality transcends any single musical style making her one of the most recognizable artists of our time.

Through a transformative gift by Younes and Soraya Nazarian, the venue was renamed The Soraya in 2017. Vibrant programming has served to establish The Soraya as the intellectual and cultural heart of the San Fernando Valley and its 1.8 million residents and as one of the top arts and culture venues in Southern California. Since its inaugural season, The Soraya has presented over 500 artists and companies across the genres of music, dance, theater, and film and is a highly in-demand location for filming and rental events.

The Soraya's 2024-25 Season boldly advances the expansive sound of orchestras both traditional and contemporary; the freestyle vibe of jazz; an array of dance luminaries, and a cultural bounty drawn from the musical well of global voices.
